innLight Debuts Molecular Massage at Spa Expo

Again and again we are surprised at all of the applications that LEDs can be used for. innLight Technologies has introduced what it calls the Molecular Massage. It is a tissue massage that reportedly uses safe and non-invasive light therapy. At a recent spa expo, 144 attendees got to try the device. About 90 percent reported profound stress relief after the treatment. The device, no larger than an average floor lamp, requires only a touch of a button to start, and it will turn itself off after 30 minutes.

This may not be as "out there" as it seems. Recently in a report from researchers entirely unrelated to this company and its product, researchers from Germany found anti-aging effects of LED light at certain wavelengths. Their findings appeared in a publication called Crystal Growth Design.
